Terms & Conditions of Membership

As a member of NQFBC and by signing the form on Page 1, I agree to:

- Submit a copy of Insurance Policy Details (minimum Third Party Liability of Three Million Pounds) and Complete and Sign the Mooring Agreement issued by the Crown Estate.
- Comply with NQFBC *Rules, Constitution, Harbour Regulations*, and *Crown Estate Protocols* regarding Moorings and Forth Port Authority rules regarding the operation of private pleasure craft on in-shore waters.
- Conduct** myself, at all times, in a manner that is **respectful** to other Members and Harbour users. Failure to do so will **affect my eligibility** for membership as stated in the **Club Constitution**.

Liability Disclaimer for use of NQFBC Equipment and Facilities

Only members over the age of eighteen (18), and with the permission of the Club Committee, are authorised to use any mechanical and/or lifting equipment provided by the club. Any member of North Queensferry Boat Club (NQFBC) using Mini Tractor and Trailer or any other Club Equipment must assume full responsibility for any and all damages, injuries or losses that may be sustained or incurred by themselves or any other person, property or animal whether associated with the NQFBC or not

They must also understand that as there is a risk of associated injuries while using said equipment to themselves or others, they may be asked to certify that they are in good physical condition and have no known disabilities that might be otherwise detrimental to themselves or others well-being.

Members agree not to bring any claim against the organization known as NQFBC or any officer of said club should they suffer any type of injury while using or being in charge of such equipment.

Members agree to accept the rulings of the committee to the use and conditions and limitations on the use of said equipment.

*Members will agree to undertake any training or induction course regarding any equipment that the committee designate and deem a requirement for using certain equipment, this will ensure each member will be able to use it responsibly and will comply with the requirements of the **Statutory Clubs Public Liability Insurance**.*
